As time came I had moved off to stay with my youngest boy and when I came home to visit I would try to get with Chris and Felicia to visit and reminisce of the old days! We had definitely gotten older and my brother Chris was having troubles with his legs as always. I had sent Tatum her Christmas Bear that I had to make up for all them years I didn't. I didn't tell them the size bear I sent. Tatum opened that bear and Chris immediately got on the phone and said dang where is she supposed to put this, Tatum could lay

on that bear and be cuddled. Felicia , Tatum I am so sorry I couldn't be there, I love Chris, and yall so much Chris will never be forgotten, I miss him so dearly and had told my wife for months I needed to get back and never could. I messaged Wednesday morning and then got the news that afternoon that my best friend was gone! I want yall to stay in touch! Love y'all and I'm sorry!

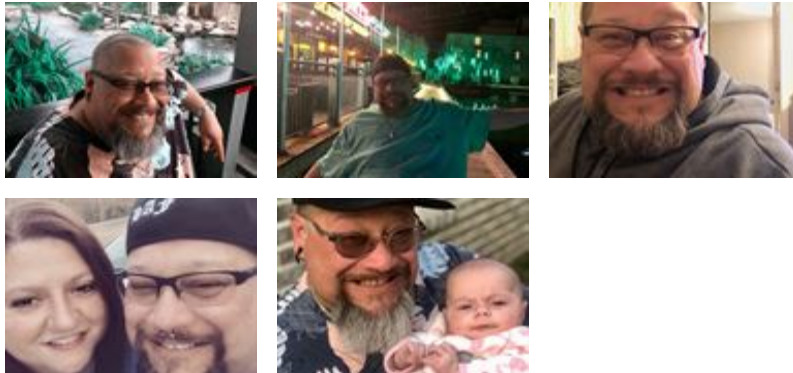
