Dennis James O'Brien, aged 83, of Horn Lake, Mississippi passed away March 10th at his home surrounded by his loving family. Dennis was a proud veteran of the United States Marine Corps Reserve and retired as a Master Gunnery Sergeant after serving our country for 33 years. He also retired as a manager from the Mississippi State Parks in 2005.
