Nancy Judalee Christopher, 76, passed away Tuesday, September 05, 2023 at her residence in Horn Lake, MS. A visitation will be held on Saturday, September 16, 2023 from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. at Coleman Funeral Home of Southaven (626 Star Landing Road East, Southaven, MS 38672.) After divorcing, her daughter Tonya was born and they lived in Memphis. She later remarried and moved to Hickory Hill in Memphis. In the late 90's and early 2000's, she worked as a part of the towing industry where she worked for Pyramid Towing and Star Wrecker Service. Although she moved around quite a bit, Tonya and Nancy bought Nancy a house in Cherokee Village, AR so that she could be closer to her sons. After finding it difficult to live on her own later in life, her daughter Tonya decided she would move her back to Horn Lake so that she could take care of her. Christy Burton also assisted in helping care for Nancy. Both of them were there with her holding her hand the day she took her last breath on

September 5th at 6:15 a.m.

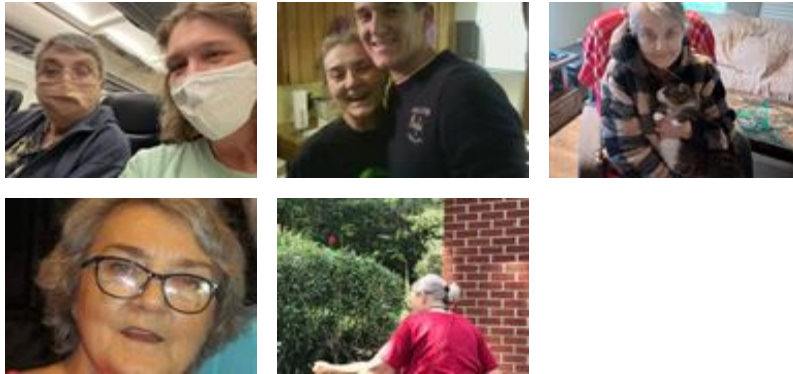
